TENTATIVE RULING

Case: Farsi v. Reedy

Plaintiff Noor Farsi's request for judicial notice is **GRANTED**. (Evid. Code, § 452, subs. (b), (d), (h).)

Plaintiff's objections to paragraph nos. 2-5, 7, and 8-12 of Kurt Wengler's declaration are **SUSTAINED**. (Evid. Code, §§ 403, 702.) The remaining objections are **OVERRULED**.

Plaintiff's objections to paragraph nos. 5-7 of Erin M. Ferguson's declaration are **SUSTAINED**. (Evid. Code, § 403, *Kelley v. Trunk* (1998) 66 Cal.App.4th 519, 524-525.) The remaining objection is **OVERRULED**.

Defendant the Regents of the University of California's motion for summary judgment is **DENIED**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 437c.) Defendant fails to submit admissible evidence to support each material fact presented in its separate statement of undisputed material facts ("UMF"). (UMF19-24, 26, and 29-32; *Hawkins vs. Wilton* (2006) 144 Cal.App.4th 936, 940; *Nazir v. United Airlines, Inc.* (2009) 178 Cal.App.4th 243; *Aguilar v. Atl. Richfield Co.* (2001) 25 Cal.4th 826, 850.)

If no hearing is requested, defendant is directed to prepare a formal order consistent with this ruling and in accordance with Code of Civil Procedure section 437c(g) and California Rule of Court 3.1312.
