Defendant Dignity Health dba Woodland Healthcare's unopposed motion for summary judgment is **GRANTED**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 437c, subds. (c) & (p)(2); Defendant's Separate Statement of Undisputed Material Facts 1-13; Decl. of Nicholas J. Leonard, Exhs. A-N; Decl. of Marvin H. Kamras, M.D., ¶¶ 1-11.) All papers submitted show that there is no triable issue as to any material fact and that defendant is entitled to judgment as a matter of law.
