Defendant Bobby Jackson's unopposed motion for a continued stay of the action is **GRANTED**. (*Pacers, Inc. v. Sup. Ct.* (1984) 162 Cal.App.3d 686.) The stay is extended to August 1, 2020.

**Case:** Pineda v. Moreno

Defendants Pedro Moreno and Hannah Barkwill's unopposed motion to compel plaintiff Alfredo Pineda to respond to form interrogatories, special interrogatories, and demands for inspection is **GRANTED**. (Code Civ. Proc., §§ 2030.290, subd. (b) & 2031.300, subd. (b).) Plaintiff shall serve verified responses, together with any responsive documents, by no later than August 16, 2019.

Monetary sanctions are **GRANTED**, against plaintiff in the amount of \$326.00. (Houze-Benson Decl., ¶ 4; Code Civ. Proc., §§ 2030.290, subd. (c) & 2031.300, subd. (c).) Plaintiff shall pay the sanction by August 30, 2019.
