Defendants Kelly Brewer and Charles Brewer's motion to quash service of summons and complaint is **DROPPED FROM CALENDAR**. A motion to quash must be set for hearing between three and seven days after it is filed, extended by 5 days if the motion is served by mail. (Code Civ. Proc., § 1167.4; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1327(a); Code Civ. Proc., § 1013, subd. (a).) The motion was required to be heard on or after August 21, 2019.
