

## Probate Notes for October 20, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Hess**  
**Case No. CV PC 13-125**

Due to the death of the conservatee, the conservatorship of the person terminated, by operation of law, December 28, 2015.

It is recommended to approve the verified second amended second and final account and report of the conservator and to grant the petition for discharge upon the filing of a final declaration with the Court showing that the remaining estate assets, if any, have been properly delivered. (Prob. Code, §§ 2467, 2620 et seq.)

**CASE:            Estate of Schmauderer**  
**Case No. CV PB 15-64**

It is recommended to grant the petition for final distribution on waiver of accounting, and to grant the petition for allowance of compensation to the attorney in the amount requested, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)

**CASE:            In the Matter of the Albertina Thomas 2003 Trust**  
**Case No. CV P2 16-152**

It is recommended to grant the unopposed petition to confirm assets to trust. (Prob. Code, § 850 et seq; *Estate of Heggstad* (1993) 16 Cal.App.4th 943.)
