

Probate Notes for October 25, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

**CASE: Conservatorship of Robb
 Case No. CV PC 16-131**

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of probate conservator of the person. (Prob. Code, § 1820 et seq.) Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.

**CASE: Conservatorship of Wademan
 Case No. CV PC 16-134**

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of probate conservator of the person. (Prob. Code, § 1820 et seq.)

**CASE: In The Matter of the J. & L. Brinley Trust
 Case No. CV P2 16-156**

It is recommended to approve the verified first and final account and report of trustees. (Prob. Code, § 17200, subd. (b)(5).) It is recommended to grant the petitions to appoint successor trustees and for order amending irrevocable trust. (Prob. Code, §§ 15409, subd. (a), 17200, subd. (b)(13), 17200, subd. (b)(10).) Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.
