

Probate Notes for July 12, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

**CASE: Estate of Denvir
Case No. CV PB 16-93**

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Paragraph eight of the petition does not include any of the alternate beneficiaries identified in paragraphs 10(A) and 10(B) of the will dated February 17, 1999 or codicil dated July 4, 1999, as persons mentioned in decedent's will.
2. Petitioner has failed to file a proof of service showing the notice of hearing was served on the alternate beneficiaries identified in paragraphs 10(A) and 10(B) in decedent's will. (Prob. Code, § 8110, subd. (b); Estate of Baird (1987) 196 Cal.App.3d 957, 961-962.)
3. Proof of publication must be filed prior to the hearing. (Prob. Code, § 8120 et seq.)

**CASE: Estate of Zamora
Case No. CV PB 16-99**

If proof of publication is filed with the Court, it is recommended to grant the petition for letters of administration, and for full authority under the Independent Administration of Estates Act. (Prob. Code, § 8000 et seq.)

**CASE: In re the Jen Toy Wong Trust
Case No. CV P2 15-778**

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the continued hearing as ordered by the Court on April 12, 2016.
