

## Probate Notes for August 5, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Cooper**  
**Case No. CV PC 15-08**

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Field**  
**Case No. CV PC 15-98**

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report and first verified account and report of conservator. (Prob. Code, §§ 1850 et seq., 2620, 1060.)

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Franklin**  
**Case No. CV PB 11-94**

The Court notes the following deficiency: The conservator failed to file the required accounting as ordered by the Court on June 24, 2016. (Prob. Code, § 2620.)

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Kuschmann**  
**Case No. CV PC 16-91**

It is recommended to grant the petitions for: 1) appointment of Loretta Davila as conservator of the person and estate, and 2) for removal of trustee of the Susanne R. Kuschmann 1999 Living Trust, for appointment of Loretta Davila as successor trustee, and for authority to revoke power of attorney. ((Prob. Code, §§ 1820 et seq, 15642, 15643, 15660, 4541.)
