

## YOLO SUPERIOR COURT EMERGENCY CONDITION CASE MANAGEMENT

### Setting Cases

Felony Arraignments – in custody – NO CHANGE – hear in D-1 at 1:30 pm

Felony Preliminary Hearings – TNW – NO CHANGE or continue 5 more court days, hear in D-7 at 1:30 am

Felony Trials – TNW – 30 day continuance from last day

Felony Sentencing other statutory deadlines – 30 day continuance from last day

All other Felony hearings – 30 day continuance or 7 weeks, whichever is most practical

Misdemeanor TNW trials – 30 day continuance from last day

Misdemeanor arraignment, out of custody – continue 7 weeks

All other misdemeanor, out of custody – continue 7 weeks or 6 months

Urgent criminal matters – hear in D-1 at 9:00 am

All Family/Civil/Probate – non-urgent – continue 7 weeks

Urgent, ex parte Family/Civil/Probate – hear on D-2 calendar @ 9:00 am

All Juvenile Justice, Dependency – D-2 at 1:30 pm, detentions NO CHANGE. Other hearings: work with the lawyers, liberal continuances min of 7 weeks; we have statutory authority to continue 300 Jurisdiction hearings 5 court weeks

Small Claims – continue 7 weeks

Unlawful Detainers – continue past May 31 per Governor

Traffic – continue 7 weeks

LPS – continue 60 days, except for urgent matters (D-2 at 9:00 am)

Child Support – continue 7 weeks

Any Urgent Matter not covered will be assigned by PJ or designee
