

Probate Notes for May 28, 2025

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please Note: The following probate matter will be heard at 9:00 a.m. in **Department Eleven**.

Case: **In the matter of Coutinho (Estate)**
Case No. PR-2023-0087

It is recommended to approve the first and final report of executor on waiver of accounting, and to grant the petition for allowance of statutory compensation to the attorney for the executor for ordinary services, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)

It is recommended for the Court to sign the lodged Order. No appearance is necessary.

Please Note: The following probate matter will be heard at 9:00 a.m. in **Department Fourteen**.

Case: **In the matter of Maxwell (Estate)**
Case No. PR-2025-0110

It is recommended to grant the petition for letters of administration, and for full authority under the Independent Administration of Estates Act. (Prob. Code, § 8000 et seq.)

It is recommended for the Court to sign the lodged Order. Petitioner is directed to lodge proposed Letters prior to the hearing. No appearance is necessary.

Case: **In the matter of Nichol (Estate)**
Case No. PR-2024-0154

Parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** and be prepared to advise the Court whether notice was given or was required under Probate Code section 9201.

If this requirement is satisfied, it is recommended that the Court approve the first and final report of personal representative on waiver of accounting, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)

Case: In the matter of Carolina Lopes Rhodes (Conservatorship)
Case No. PR-2023-0314

It is recommended to approve the verified final report due to resignation of co-conservator.
(Prob. Code § 2640.)

It is recommended to approve the fifth verified account and report of [co]conservator and request for authorization to sell conservatee's former residence. (Prob. Code, §§ 1060, 2541.5, 2620.)

It is recommended to defer approval of the Confidential Care Plan pending provision of the Court investigator's report for the July 11, 2025, biennial review hearing. The Court will also set the next biennial review at the July 11th hearing.

It is recommended for the Court to sign the lodged Orders. No appearance is necessary.
