Defendants Craig A. Hollowell and Laquashanda A. Hollowell's demurrer to plaintiff Cameron Miles Nutter's complaint is **SUSTAINED WITHOUT LEAVE TO AMEND**. (Code Civ. Proc., § 430.10, subd. (e).) The three-day notice to pay rent or quit fails to state that Saturdays and Sundays and other judicial holidays were excluded from defendants' three-day deadline to either pay rent or surrender possession of the premises. (Code Civ. Proc., § 1161, subd. (2); Complaint, ¶ 9(e), Exhibit 2.) Further, the notice does not provide the telephone number of the person to whom the rent payment shall be made. (Code Civ. Proc., § 1161, subd. (2); Complaint, ¶ 9(e), Exhibit 2.) As plaintiff did not strictly comply with the statutory requirements, he cannot maintain the unlawful detainer action against defendants. (*Kwok v. Bergren* (1982) 130 Cal.App.3d 596, 599–600.)

If no hearing is requested, this tentative ruling is effective immediately. No formal order pursuant to California Rules of Court, rule 3.1312 or further notice is required.
