

Probate Notes for November 21, 2025

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please Note: The following probate matter will be heard at 9:00 a.m. in **Department Fourteen.**

**Case: In the matter of Anna Richardson (Limited Conservatorship)
 Case No. PR-2025-0144**

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Proof that the citation and petition were served on the proposed conservatee at least 15 days before the *continued* hearing date has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1824.)
2. Petitioner has not provided any legal authority authorizing the Court to order an exception to the bond requirement. (Prob. Code, § 2320.)
3. The *Confidential Declaration on Medical Ability to Attend Hearing - Probate Conservatorship Form* (GC-325) has not been filed with the Court or the proposed conservatee has not otherwise been excused from being produced at the hearing. (Prob. Code, § 1825.)

Parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR.** (Prob. Code, § 1825.) Parties should be prepared to discuss Alta California Regional Center's recommendation to only grant two of the five powers requested.
