3 GENERAL ORDER RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF
4 AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115 BY CHAIR
5 OF JUDICIAL COUNCIL

6 Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the
7 September 9, 2021 Order (“Order”) of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the
8 Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the September 8, 2021 request for an
9 emergency order made by the Superior Court of Yolo County (“Court”), this Court HEREBY
10 FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

11 1. In cases in which the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from September
12 9, 2021, to September 30, 2021, inclusive, any judge of the Court may extend the time period
13 provided in section 825 of the Penal Code within which a defendant charged with a felony
14 offense must be taken before a magistrate from 48 hours to not more than 7 days (Gov. Code,
15 § 68115(a)(8)); and

16 2. In cases in which the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from September
17 9, 2021, to September 30, 2021, inclusive, any judge of the Court may extend the time period
18 provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than
19 30 days (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10)).
