3 GENERAL ORDER RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF
4 AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115 BY CHAIR
5 OF JUDICIAL COUNCIL

6 Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the April 21,
7 2021 Order (“Order”) of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of
8 California, issued in response to the April 19, 2021 request for an emergency order made by the
9 Superior Court of Yolo County (“Court”), this Court HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS
10 FOLLOWS:

- 11 1. In cases in which the statutory deadline otherwise would expire from May 1, 2021, to
12 May 30, 2021, inclusive, any judge of the Court *may* extend the time period provided
13 in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than
14 30 days (Gov. Code, §68115(a)(10)); and
- 15 2. In cases in which the statutory deadline otherwise would expire on May 1, 2021 to
16 May 30, 2021, inclusive, any judge of the Court *may* extend the time periods
17 provided in sections 583.310 and 583.320 of the Code of Civil Procedure to bring an
18 action to trial by not more than 30 days (Gov. Code, §68115(a)(6)).
