IMPLEMENTATION OF JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF CALIFORNIA STATEWIDE
EMERGENCY ORDER BY HON. TANI G. CANTIL-SAKAUYE, CHIEF JUSTICE OF
CALIFORNIA AND CHAIR OF THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL MARCH 30, 2020

Pursuant to the Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakaue’s Emergency Order issued on
March 30, 2020, the Superior Court of Yolo County, the Court **HEREBY FINDS AND
ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

A judge may extend the time period provided in section 859b of the Penal Code for the
holding of a preliminary examination and the defendant’s right to release from 10 court days to
not more than 30 court days, to the extent necessary and appropriate to accommodate delays
caused by the COVID-19 Pandemic.
